CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

To assist the County parents should :

- Take an interest in their child's activity and progress and be supportive
- Introduce themselves to the adults involved in the supervision of County junior activities, spend some time talking to the Junior Delegate, P.G.A. Professional Coach and the County Secretary who is the lead officer for Child Protection
- Obtain any good practice guidance for children from the County Union and go through it with your child
- Be punctual when dropping off and picking up your children for/from coaching, competitions and matches.
- Take an interest in whom your son is playing with
- Have clear lines of communication to keep up with your child's progress
- Ensure that the County Organiser of an event has an emergency contact number for you when you are away from the club – a mobile would be preferable, and that you leave your mobile on so that you can be contacted in an emergency
- Advise the County Secretary if your child has particular needs (allergies, physical disabilities, learning disabilities) to ensure your child is provided for in the best way possible by completing the Junior Player Profile Form and Match Consent Forms.
